

▲ Plan Sunday Evening ▲

Objectives: LEAD participants will work through differing opinions and ideas to come to a workable solution for an activity for the entire camp on Sunday evening.

General guidelines:

1. Respect your group; treat others as you want to be treated
2. Apply principles from Communication and Conflict lesson

Evening activity guidelines

1. The LEADs will run the evening - giving directions and answering questions
2. Plan for about 1 hour 15 minutes (7:30-8:30pm)
3. Campers will be in pajamas - they will go back to their divisions and get ready for bed BEFORE the activity.
4. One staff member will give a brief devotional talk to all campers after the activity. Plan this to be at a place that works well for this, preferable with a campfire.
5. The activity must include all campers of all ages
6. It should be a "chill" evening - either in the Dining Hall and/or Rec Hall or on the Green
7. You can use anything in the Rec Hall (games, etc)
8. You can use supplies from the craft porch if you coordinate with the Specialist
9. You may coordinate ahead of time with any specialist or staff member for extra supplies / support
10. A simple plan will most likely be the best plan
11. GOAL: while we want a good activity for the camp, the main goal is to work well with the LEAD group in planning the activity - and to use the communication lessons you have learned, both in class and in life
